Ruth 1.16-17

Where you go, I will go;
Where you lodge, I will lodge;
your people shall be my people,
and your God my God.

Deut. 6.4-9

- Hear, O Israel: The Lord is our God, the Lord alone. You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, and with all your soul, and with all your might. Keep these words that I am commanding you today in your heart. Recite them to your children and talk about them when you are at home and when you are away, when you lie down and when you rise. Bind them as a sign on your hand, fix them as an emblem on your forehead, and write them on the doorposts of your house and on your gates.

Jesus:

- And remember, I am with you always, to the end of the age (Mt.8.28)
- And I will ask the Father, and he will give you another Advocate (“the Spirit of Truth,”) to be with you forever. (Jn. 14.16)
- But the Advocate, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in my name, will teach you everything and remind you of all that I have said to you. Peace I leave with you; my peace I give to you. (Jn. 14.26-27)

Paul:

- For I am convinced that neither death, nor life, nor angels, nor rulers, nor things present, nor things to come, nor powers, nor height, nor depth, nor anything else in all creation will be able to separate us from the love of God in Christ Jesus our Lord. (Rom. 8.38-39)
